Login to Etsy

After logging in go to the shop manager

Copy the link at the top right of the screen.




2 step

Authentication process

When you have the oauth token, now you can authenticate. When you create an Etsy integration you will be redirected to this page. For the store name you will have to enter the copied link.

Press “**Continue**” and proceed with the authentication process.




